1. The member of the International Advisory Board shall have the same or equivalent qualifications as any member of the IAMG.
2. She/he shall not be a citizen of India at the time of invitation.
3. The member shall have a high standing in medical genetics as evidenced by her/his publications.
4. The member is expected to provide advice and guidance on scientific and academic matters to the IAMG.
5. Invitations will be sent by the president only after the approval of the executive committee.
6. Any executive committee member can nominate a medical genetics expert for membership of the international advisory board along with the complete biodata of the nominee. The executive committee shall take a decision on the nomination.
7. The appointment shall be for a period of five years. However it may be renewed by the executive committee for subsequent terms of five years each.
8. The maximum number of International Advisory Board members shall not exceed ten at any given point of time.
9. It is desirable that the member enhances the visibility of IAMG and helps the society and its members in networking with other scientists.
10. The advisory board member may attend meetings of the IAMG as per his/ her convenience; however, this is not mandatory as the IAMG does not wish to cause any burden on the time or activities of its advisors. In case a member of the advisory board wishes to attend an IAMG meeting, he/ she may use travel grants at his/her disposal or the IAMG may arrange funds for the same.
11. There will be no legal or financial obligations on the member towards the IAMG.
12. This is an honor conferred by the IAMG and does not involve any material benefit to the member or his organization.
